To whom it may Concern:

This letter serves to outline and clarify the proper procedure for the addition of new shooting categories within the sport of Cowboy Action Shooting, as defined by The Single Action Shooting Society[®] (SASS[®]) rules and guidelines, and how the process directly affects the addition of shooting categories at the SASS European Regional, 2012.

New categories may be offered and experimented with on the local club level at all of our more than 700 affiliated clubs worldwide. If a category offered at the local level continuously and consistently attracts shooters within that category, the regional match directors can be petitioned to offer the category at a higher match level, at their discretion. The request can then be escalated for the official addition of a SASS Shooting Category through the clubs TG (description below) for voting purposes at the annual TG Summit.

Each local club is presided over by a SASS[®] Territorial Governor (TG). Each club is represented by their TG annually at the SASS[®] TG Summit, a forum for consistency and communication for all clubs worldwide. An open forum for consideration and discussion, followed by voting on such items as new categories, are then offered to all TG's.

It is with great anticipation that we fully support the initial step of a trial phase with addition of two (2) categories at the GTR's German Territorial Roundup, The SASS[®] European Regional in 2012. The proposed categories of 1880 BP and Frontier Classic show great potential to be incorporated into official SASS[®] Shooting categories in the future, using the process outlined above.
